QUALITY CRAFT IDEAS

BOW, MERMAID AND BUTTERFLY CLIPS



YOU WILL NEED

1. Metal hair grips
2. Glue gun and glue sticks
3. Glitter fabric or Faux leather fabric sheets
4. Templates

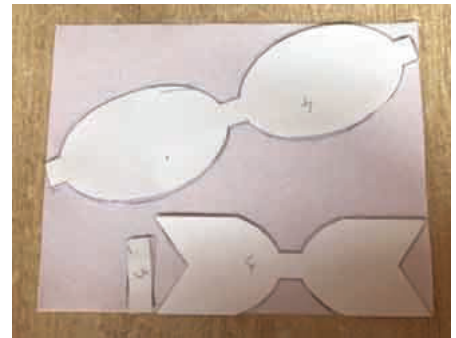


CONTENTS

- 1. Bow
- 5. Mermaid
- 8. Butterfly

BOW

1. Lay the templates* out on the reverse of your fabric and cut around them.



2. Place a dot of glue in the centre of the double oval piece.



3. Fold one oval over and press the tab end onto the glue.



BOW CONT'D

4. Repeat on the other side.



5. Add a dot of glue to the front of the double tulip shaped piece and press your folded piece onto the glue to make a bow shape.



6. Position the small rectangle under the centre of the bow.



7. Put a dot of glue on the centre of the bow back and fold the rectangle in.

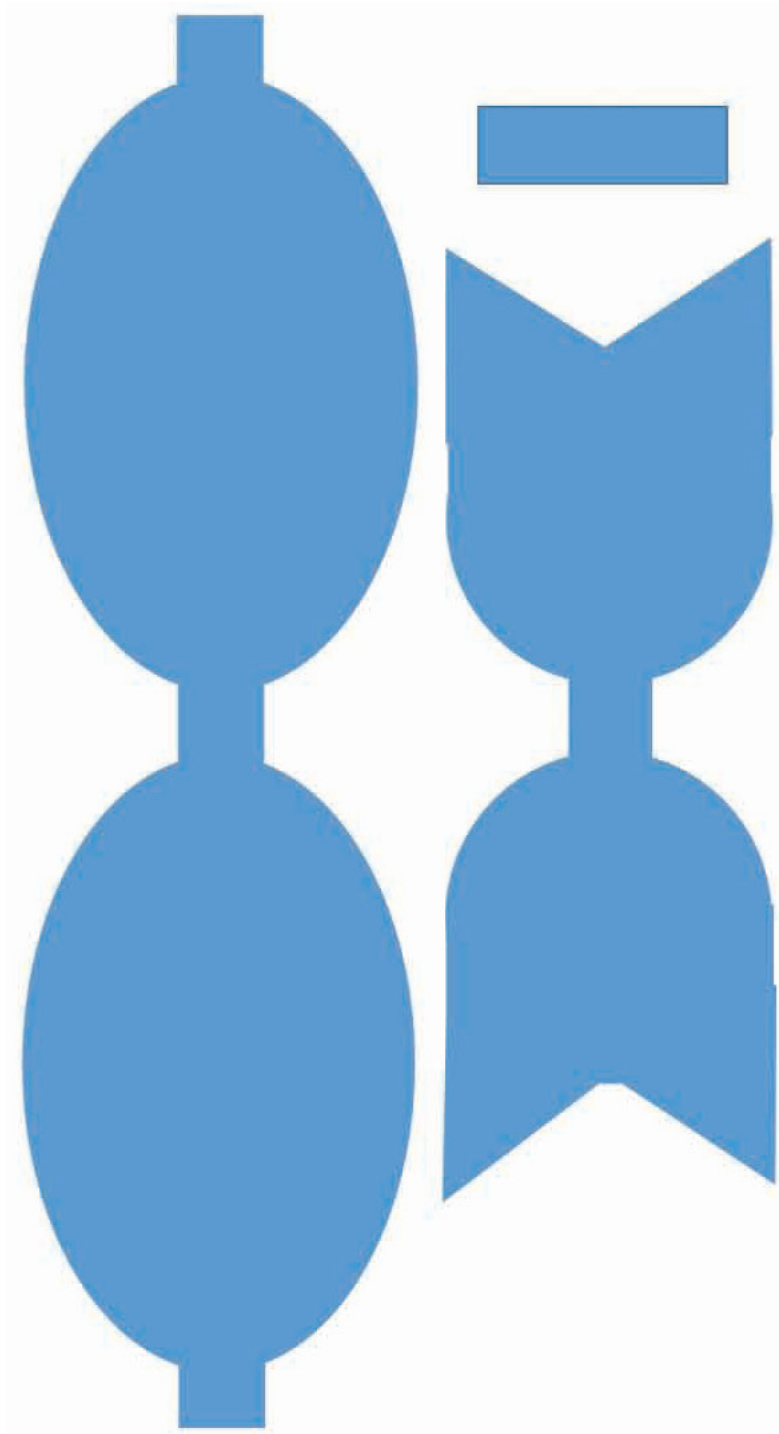


BOW CONT'D

8. Glue the metal hair grip to the centre back of the bow.



BOW TEMPLATE



MERMAID

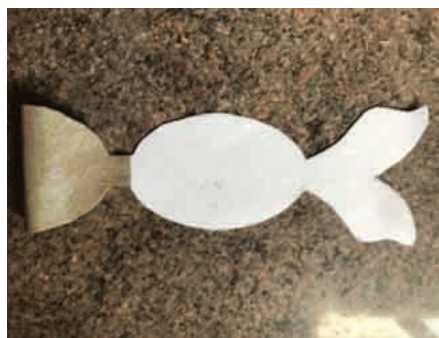
1. You will need 2 different pieces of fabric for the mermaid. Draw around the pieces on the back of your fabrics and cut out.



2. Take the single oval, put a dot of glue on one tab and fold over right side out



3. Put a dot of glue where the tail joins the oval and fold so that the second oval makes a bow shape.



MERMAID CONT'D

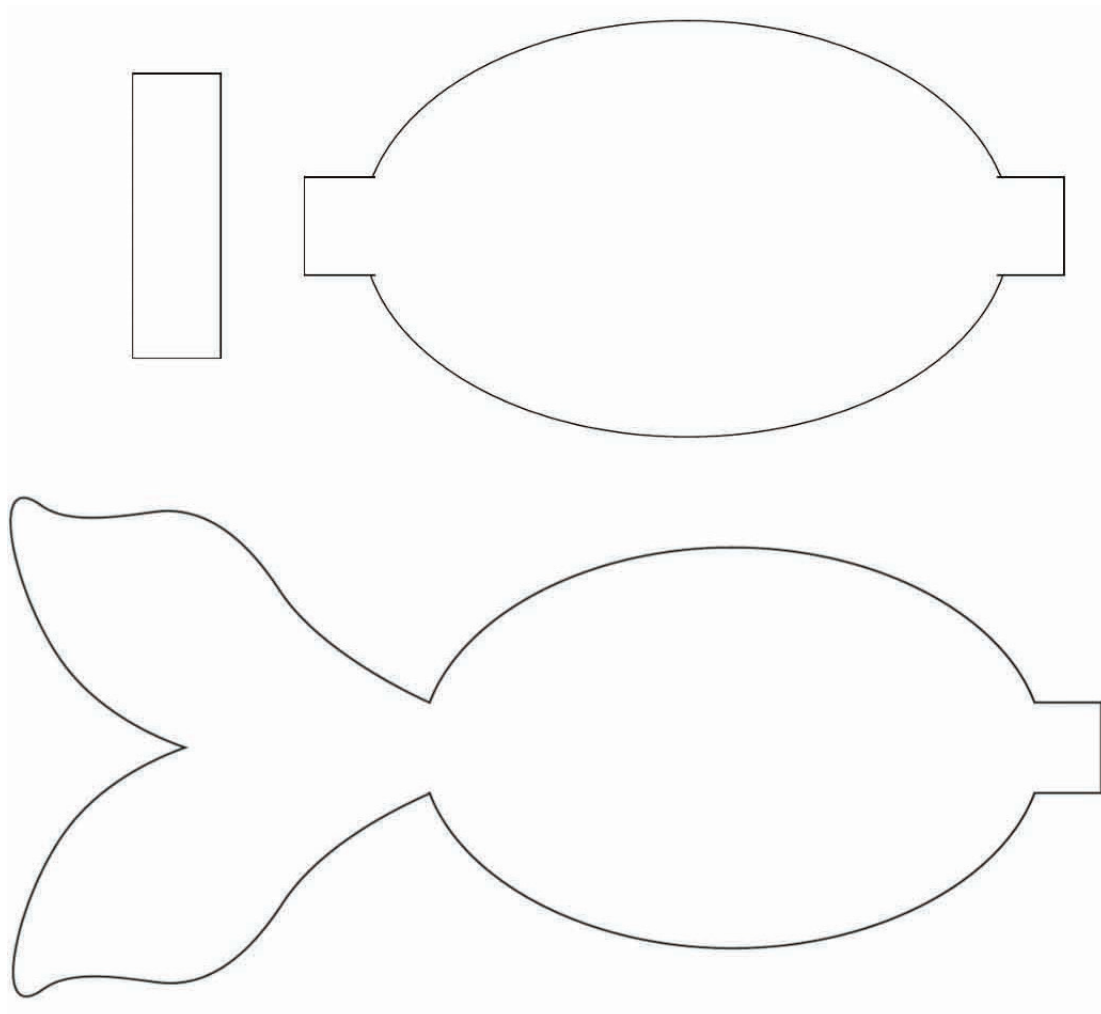
4. Position the rectangular piece under the mermaid bow and glue, cinching in the bow to create a pleat.



5. Attach to a metal clip.



MERMAID TEMPLATE



BUTTERFLY

1. Cut around the butterfly and rectangular piece.



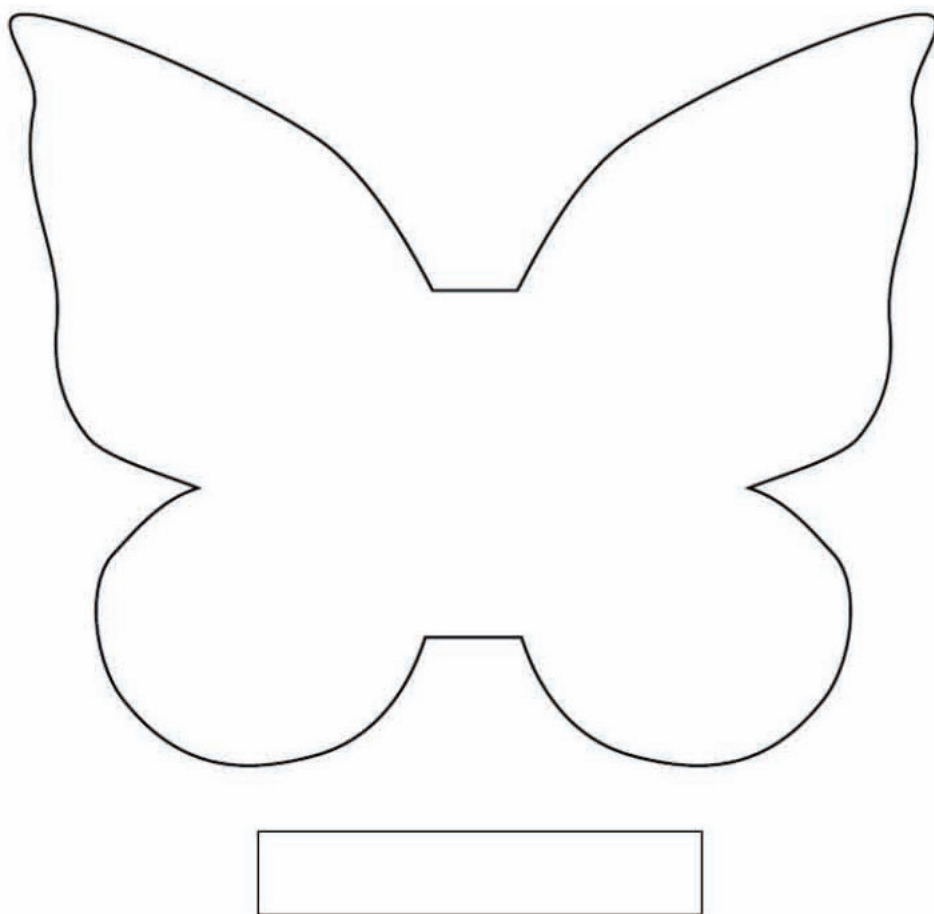
2. Position the rectangular piece under the butterfly, cinch the butterfly in to create a pleat and glue the rectangle around it.



3. Glue the metal clip to the back of the bow.
