OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD
QUALITY CRAFT IDEAS

FABRIC PEN OR PENCIL ROLL



YOU WILL NEED

1. Three pieces of fabric,
measuring approx. 30cm x 22cm
2. Two pieces of fabric approx. 30cm x 5cm
3. Pack of pens or coloured pencils
4. Sewing machine



Wrong side

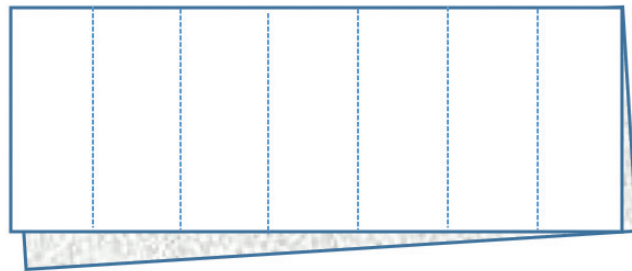


Right side

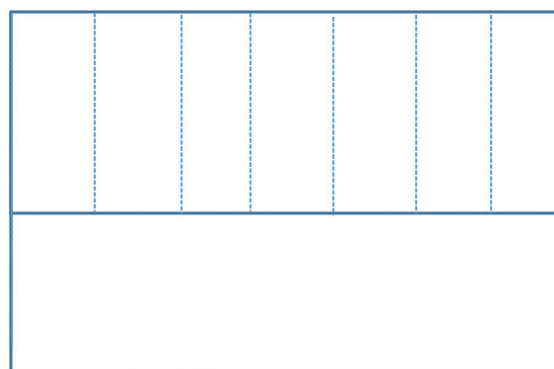
1. Take the 2 pieces of fabric measuring 30cm x 5cm, fold in half and sew along the long edge and one short edge leaving a 1cm seam allowance. Turn right side out. These will form the ties for your pencil case.



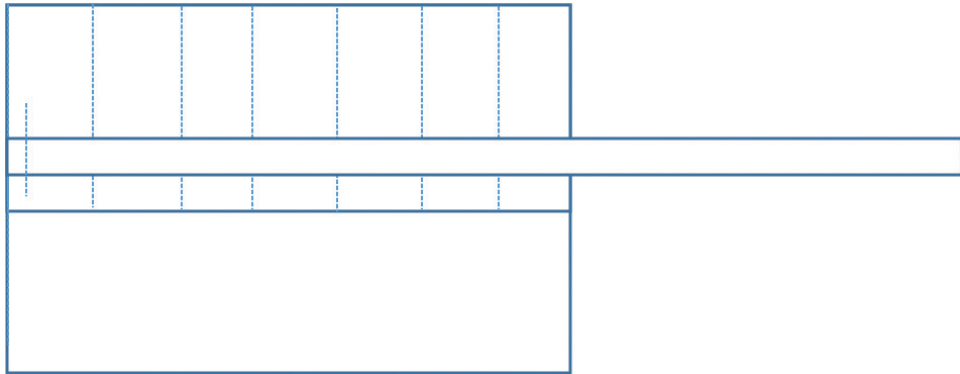
2. Fold one piece of fabric measuring 30cm x 22cm in half lengthways and mark off lines for the pen slots. This will form the pocket section.



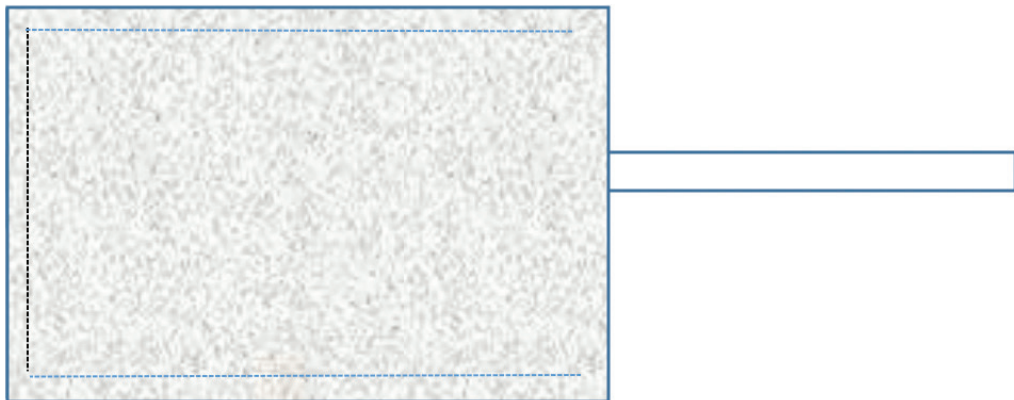
3. Pin this piece of fabric to one of the other pieces and sew along the division lines.



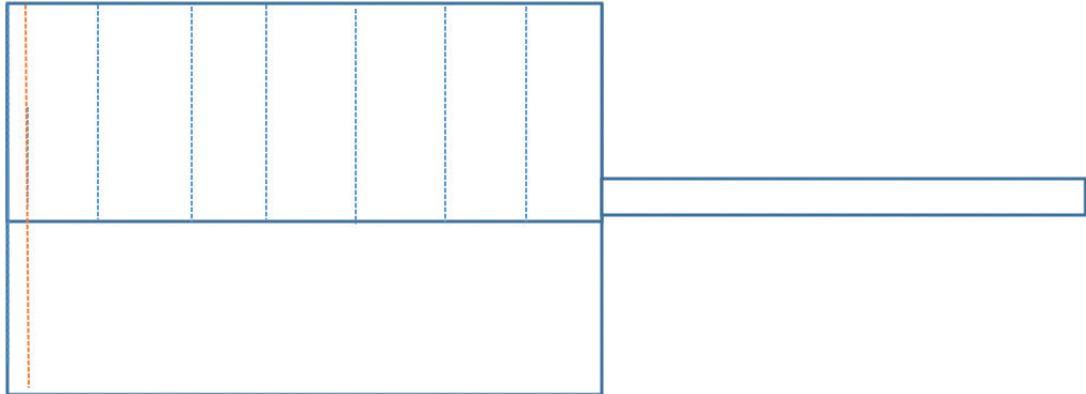
4. Lay the 2 ties along the centre of the fabric pin to one short end and baste in place.



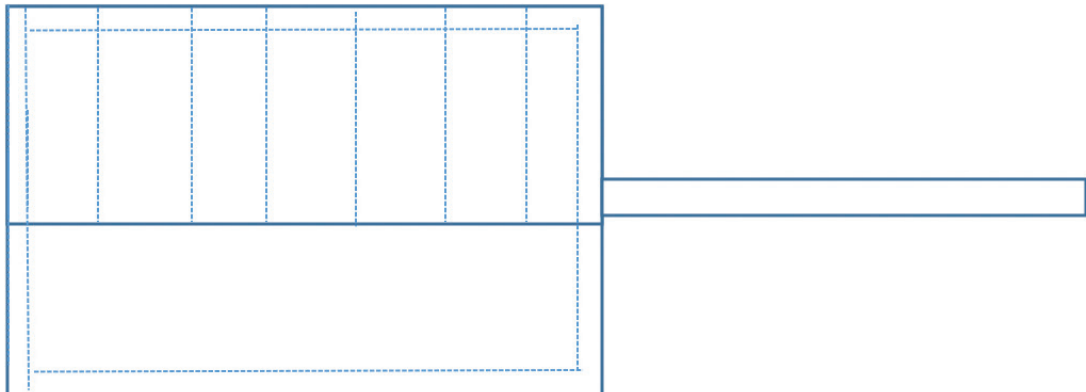
5. Pin the third piece of fabric wrong side out to the front of the pocket section. Pin this piece of fabric to one of the other pieces and sew along the division lines. Sew around 3 edges including the basted short edge.



6. Turn right side out.



7. Pin under the remaining short side.
Sew around the full edge of the fabric to flatten the case.



8. Fill with pens, roll up and tie!
